### The Volunteer's Role

Cuso International and the Canadian Association of Midwives (CAM) are co-implementing the "Midwives Save Lives" (MSL) project with the financial support of Global Affairs Canada. This initiative echoes the growing consensus on the key role midwifery and midwifery associations can play in reducing maternal and newborn morbidity and mortality in countries such as Tanzania.

This placement will support the efforts aimed at strengthening the capacity of the Tanzania Midwives Association (TAMA) to in area of monitoring and evaluation of the projects, and with key RMNCH stakeholders. Effective monitoring and evaluation will allow an association to ensure accountability, transparency as well as report progress on the implementation of strategic plans, programs or smaller projects. It will also help to strengthen working relationships internally, between elected officers of the board and members of the association, or externally with RMNCH stakeholders.

#### Overall Objectives:

- Implement activities aimed at strengthening the partner association's capacity in the field of project monitoring and evaluation;
- Support partner associations and the country in the collection and transmission of monitoring data to the project management team;
- Assist the conduct of satisfaction surveys and other assessments or investigations;
- Support partner associations in the drafting of the various monitoring reports

#### As a volunteer, you will:

- Complete activity tracking and beneficiary counting sheets
- Prepare monitoring reports as per work plans
- Identify and document significant changes
- Assist with the development of data collection tools



- Support TAMA in developing its Monitoring and Evaluation framework; Implement capacity building activities for partners

#### **Essential Academic Qualifications:**

- Bachelor in public health, social sciences (sociology, anthropology) or any other field related to development. Competencies in statistics would be an asset

#### **Essential Professional Background:**

- At least two years experience in monitoring & evaluation
- Experience in participatory data collection with stakeholders (beneficiary, partners, staff)

#### **Support Package**

- Modest monthly living allowance (varies depending country)
- Accommodation while in placement
- Return airfare and visa/work permit costs
- Cost of required vaccinations, antimalarial medication, and health insurance
- Pre-departure training and in-country orientation

- Travel and accommodation for the five-day pre-departure training course and for in-country orientation
- Bonus: Additional return flight home or cash in lieu after 12 months of service for volunteers who extend for another 6 months
